S1 – S6	<p><u>Movement around the school during prelims</u></p> <p>Prelim exams for S4-6 will begin on Monday 29th January and run until Wednesday 7th February. It is very important that all pupils listen very carefully to, and then follow, these instructions about movement and the level of noise around the school.</p> <p>During the prelim exams there will be the following changes to movement around the school for pupils.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. E-Block: All classes in E block will be let out a couple of minutes before the bell at the end of lessons so that pupils can descend the main stairs. Pupils must not use the stairs beside E7. 2. B Block – the doors beside B6 will be locked throughout the prelims and pupils will have to go the long way round to get to classrooms in the main building and E Block. 3. The area outside the Social Area is out of bounds at all times during the prelims and must not be used between lessons to go from one class to another, or at break or lunchtimes. Pupils going to and coming from the Co op at lunchtime must keep well away from the Social Area. This is to ensure that pupils sitting their exams are not disturbed. The Social Area Foyer is out of bounds to all pupils at all times unless they are moving from one lesson to another or are in S4-6 and are waiting for an exam to start. 4. Pupils are asked to keep noise to a minimum when moving around the school especially in and around the Social Area Foyer and outside rooms where there are 'Exams in Progress' signs. 	G Oldham
