	<ul> <li>At no time during the school day, is food or drink (except water) allowed on the first floor.</li> <li>Before Registration at 8.38am the first floor is closed to all S1-S3 pupils.</li> <li>At lunchtime, the first floor is closed to all pupils for the first twenty minutes.</li> <li>The only exceptions to these two rules about opening times are pupils with passes from Guidance and those taking part in clubs.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Whilst pupils are on the First Floor, they are expected to:</li> <li>Be respectful to all staff, learners and events taking place.</li> <li>Abide by MERIT expectations</li> <li>Have no food or drink, except water.</li> </ul>
