(Reg/Crew: please issue demerits if any pupils attend in PE kit as they have time to change even if it is P1)</li> <li>Appropriate footwear should be worn on the astro at all times. No footwear is not acceptable. Please bring suitable footwear for PE lessons.</li> <li>No phones should be brought into practical lessons. These can be placed in the valuables tray (recommended) or left in bag in changing room (own risk).</li> </ul>


