S1 – S6	Scottish Mathematical Challenge 2024-25	D Forbes
	For anyone interested in challenging Mathematics problems. There are different levels of competitions for different age groups.	
	The Challenge is a maths problem-solving competition for school students across Scotland, now in its 50th year. There are two rounds of problems where students work on the questions in their own time, and submit them through their school. At the end of the competition around half of all entrants receive either a Gold, Silver or Bronze award certificate. Gold and Silver awardees also receive a prize mug. The Challenge gives a chance to demonstrate ability in maths and be rewarded for it; with three levels of award, recognition is not restricted to the top performers alone.  If anyone is interested in taking part, or finding out more information, please go to room B18 before Friday 27th September, or speak to your Maths teacher in class.
