S1 – S6	Reminder – First Floor Expectation	
	<ul> <li>Due to an increasing number of students carrying food on the first floor, a reminder of the First Floor Expectations for all S1 to S6 pupils: <ul> <li>At no time during the school day, is food or drink (except water) allowed on the first floor.</li> <li>Before Registration at 8.38am the first floor is closed to all S1-S3 pupils.</li> <li>At lunchtime, the first floor is closed to all pupils for the first twenty minutes.</li> <li>The only exceptions to these two rules about opening times are pupils with passes from Guidance and those taking part in clubs.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Whilst pupils are on the First Floor, they are expected to: <ul> <li>Be respectful to all staff, learners and events taking place.</li> <li>Abide by MERIT expectations.</li> <li>Have no food or drink, except water.</li> </ul> </li> <li>If they do not, they will be expected to leave the First Floor.</li> </ul>
