S1 – S6	Reminder – First Floor Expectation	E McCluskey
	 Due to an increasing number of students carrying food on the first floor, a reminder of the First Floor Expectations for all S1 to S6 pupils: At no time during the school day, is food or drink (except water) allowed on the first floor. Before Registration at 8.38am the first floor is closed to all S1-S3 pupils. At lunchtime, the first floor is closed to all pupils for the first twenty minutes. The only exceptions to these two rules about opening times are pupils with passes from Guidance and those taking part in clubs. Whilst pupils are on the First Floor, they are expected to: Be respectful to all staff, learners and events taking place. Abide by MERIT expectations. Have no food or drink, except water. If they do not, they will be expected to leave the First Floor.

	Please could pupils be reminded: - A change of PE kit is required for PE lessons. If you forget, we have spare kit available. 
