Digital Mental Health Services for Aberdeenshire residents

From the **21st June**, children, young people and adults living in Aberdeenshire can access online digital services to support positive mental health and wellbeing.

Kooth is a service for children and young people aged 10–18 years (up to 19th birthday) that offers a free online counselling and emotional well-being support service. It provides a safe and secure means of accessing support from a professional team of qualified professionals, as well as providing access to many self-help tools and content. To access please register using this link <u>www.kooth.com</u>

Togetherall provides support for young people and adults aged 16 years and upwards. Trained accredited professionals are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, meaning that any adult who may be struggling can chose from a range of safe therapeutic services at a time that best suits them. This service can be accessed by inputting your postcode at <u>www.togetherall.com</u> and creating a completely anonymous user account.
